The 14th East Kilbride Community Arts Exhibition will be held within the Old Parish Church Hall, Glebe Street on Saturday 4th and Sunday 5th November 2017.

Work in painting, drawing, sculpture, printmaking, collage, textile art, pottery and photography may be submitted. Paintings must be properly framed and ready to hang. All artwork should have a tie-on label giving the artist's name, title of the work, medium and the purchase price.

The event will be managed on behalf of the Old Parish Church in conjunction with East Kilbride Arts Group and other local artists. Funds raised from the event will be directed to support the magnificent services of Kilbryde Hospice.

Artists display work entirely at their own risk. No responsibility is accepted by EK Old Parish Church or the Arts Group for any damage or loss

Please complete the attached entry form and return it to Reception at East Kilbride Arts Centre, in an envelope clearly marked 'November Community Arts Exhibition Entry' as soon as possible. **Artists will be limited to entry of <u>two</u> items**. Entries will not be accepted after **17 October**. A handling fee of **£6** must accompany the entry form. Cheques should be made payable to EK Old Parish Church. A commission fee of 25% will be applied to all sales of artwork.

All artwork must be delivered to the Church Hall, Glebe Street on **Thursday 2 November between 10 am and 1 pm.** when artists will be given a receipt. Sales monies and unsold artwork should be collected on Sunday 5 November between 4 pm and 5 pm. Receipts will show a time for collection of sales monies and unsold artwork. Artists should be prepared to settle the commission costs by cash or cheque at this time. Prior to removing unsold artwork artists should produce their receipt for checking by stewards.
